This show is a qualifier for the **2018 BSPS Summer Championships Show**, to be held at Arena UK. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed ponies in the Heritage Lead Rein and Heritage First Ridden classes and the 1st 2nd 3rd and 4th prize winners in the Heritage Open Ridden, Heritage Open WHP. Classes will qualify for the BSPS Championships Show, provided the animal is registered in accordance with Rules 5 and 28 and ridden by a BSPS member.

RULE 5. Exhibitors in qualifying positions, who have never been members of the BSPS are allowed 7 working days in which to become members and register their ponies. Please note this Rule does not apply to classes with HOYS, RIHS, Olympia or Blue Riband Qualifications.

RULE 28. Owners, Riders and Ponies must be registered BEFORE the date of the Show at which they qualify, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies. This Rule does not apply to classes with RIHS or Olympia qualification.

This show is a qualifier for the **"Black Country Saddles" BSPS Best Rider of the Year**. The Best Rider in the Heritage Lead Rein, Heritage First Ridden and the best rider 25 years and under in the Heritage Open Ridden & Heritage Open WHP (eligible riders to wear an armband) will receive a Card and qualify for the final at the BSPS Championships Show.

NPS Scotland Rules 2018

Ponies may only qualify **once** for each NPS Scotland Competition Final. Ponies that take a second qualifier for the same section will not be allowed to enter the final.

All Mountain & Moorland Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective stud book. Part bred, X registered ponies, ponies in the appendices of their main stud book and Eriskays are not eligible.

Qualification in the M. & M In Hand Section may go to 3rd in the Championship. All others may go to no lower than 4th place.

A Judge is not obliged to award an NPS Scotland Finals qualification if he/she feels that the pony is not of a sufficient standard

CDE Competitors qualifying at Shows held before Monday 4th June 2018 must send their qualifying card and entries in by Thursday 28th June 2018. Shows after 5th June 2018 adhere to a closing date of 1st August 2018 and Late Entries will NOT be accepted. Competitors that qualify at late shows after the 1st August 2018 are required to email the secretary and send in the qualifying cards within 3 days of the show.

Cavasson nosebands are the only nosebands permitted in flat ridden classes.

Entry for the Finals can only be made by sending the official card duly signed by the Judge at the time of qualifying with your entry form. The OWNER must be or become a member of NPS Scotland before entering the Finals. All ridden ponies must be shown off the lead rein except in the specified Lead Rein Qualifier Class. In Mountain and Moorland classes riders of stallions must be 12 years old or over when riding small breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B). For large breeds (Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D) riders of stallions must be 14 years old or over. A child must have attained their 12th birthday as of the 1st January in the current year to either strip or lunge pony at a NPS show, except for stallions where age will same as in the Rule Book to ride a stallion. Handlers of stallions or colts must be 14 years old or over. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear a correctly secured skull caps/riding hat that meets the current standards. The Final will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 24th August 2018.

NPS Scotland/Baileys Horse Feeds Open Ridden Mountain & Moorland Championship.

The 2 highest placed ponies, not already qualified, in each class will qualify for the Final which will take place at the Blair Castle International Horse Trials on Friday 24th August 2018. **Qualifications to go no lower than 4th place.** This can be either mixed M. & M. or Breed Classes

TSR Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2018 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers **MUST** have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available **FREE** from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

TSR Medal Awards - TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

- 2) The Organisers retain the right to refuse entry, or to amend the details of the schedule if the instances of the programme require, and to cancel any class with insufficient entries.
- 3) The organisers reserve the right to exclude from the meeting or remove from the showground any person or property for any reason and without giving any reason.
- 4) All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- 5) The organisers may in any dispute or any other matter act or decide in any manner they think fit.
- 6) Signature by the person making the entries shall be deemed to be an acceptance of the conditions herein contained.
- 7) **NO LATE OR UNPAID ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**
- 8) Stabling available on site at £25 per night – straw only provided. Shavings extra. **Stables MUST be left clean and tidy.** Stabling to be booked and paid at time of entry.
- 9) ****Prizes will only be awarded:** If there are 6 or more entries – 1st prize only, 10 entries – 1st and 2nd prizes, 14 or more entries – 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes will be awarded. **** 1st prize will be awarded in all BSPS classes.**
- 10) **Liability** – Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of Mundole Equestrian (ME) or anyone for who they are in law responsible, neither ME to which these rules apply or any

agent, other employee or representative accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any person whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or any other way.

11) **NO CLEANING OUT BOXES IN SHOW FIELD OR BOX PARKING AREA**

12) **Withdrawals** – once a competitor's entry has been accepted it will be assumed that he/she intends to take part unless he/she notifies the organiser to the contrary. Competitors must therefore declare their intention to withdraw by **Fri 20 April 2018. No refunds will be made after this date.**
