To make competitions fair we do encourage those who have had clear rounds consistently at one height to move up to the next class

Those who achieve 4 double clear rounds will compete at Finals on 25 October as follows:

0.45 and 0.60 will qualify at 0.60
0.70 and 0.80 will qualify at 0.80
0.90 and 1.00 will qualify at 1.00
1.05 and above will qualify at 1.20

Rules

1. Entries need to be with Secretary before entering arena
2. Competitors need to have their own insurance
3. All muck and hay to be picked up before leaving box park
4. Do not clean out horsebox/trailer in box park. Please leave it clean and tidy as you find it.
5. The judges decision is final.
6. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, or to amend details of the schedule if the instances of the programme require and to cancel any class with insufficient entries.
7. The organisers reserve the right to exclude from the meeting or remove from the show ground any person or property for any reason and without giving a reason.
8. All dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.
9. The organisers may in any dispute or any other matter act or decide in any manner they think fit.
10. Liability – Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of ME or anyone for who they are in law responsible, neither ME to which these rules apply or any agent, other employee or representative accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any person whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or any other way.
