No one to enter box park more than an hour before your first time. Please tick off your name on board at Arena when you arrive and walk your course. Course walks available 10 minutes before each class commences.

**NO PERSON WITH COVID SYMPTONS TO ENTER MUNDOLE EQUESTRIAN.** Each horse/pony will be given a time and the order of going will be on display. Check your time in case of late cancellations. Social distancing is very important. No person to enter Secretary or Judges caravans. Please clear any hay or muck dropped and take all litter home with you.

Pre booked stabling available £25 per night with straw provided. Shavings £10 extra.

### Working Hunter Classes

1 Working Hunter Nursery Stakes (fences: max. 0.50m) Open to ponies not exceeding 148cm, ridden by riders 12yrs & under on the day

2 Working Hunter Nursery Stakes (fences: max. 0.50m) Open to horses and ponies, rider any age

3 Working Hunter (Fences 0.60) Ridden by riders under 16yrs on day of show

4 Working Hunter (Fences 0.60) Open to horses and ponies. Rider any age.

5 Working Hunter (Fences 0.80) Open to horses and ponies, riders under 16 on day of show.

6 Working Hunter (Fences 0.80) Open to horses and ponies, rider any age.

7 Working Hunter (Fences 1.00) Open to horses and ponies, riders under 16 on day of show.

8 Working Hunter (Fences 1.00) Open to horses and ponies, rider any age.

Depending on entries classes may be amalgamated. Horses/ponies may not enter more than 2 classes.

There are 2 Warm Up areas, no more than 4 horses allowed in each at any time. Warm Up 1 is a walking only area. From either Warm Up area riders will go to the RED area, 3 minutes before their time. They will proceed to the YELLOW, then GREEN areas as these become vacant. GREEN allows rider to enter Arena on judge's command. Riders exit arena straight in to box park and return to their horse box/prepare for their next class. No grazing allowed. When finished competing please tidy up and leave box park as soon as practicable. We hope you enjoy the competitions and if you have any suggestions we are always happy to receive feedback.

Toilet on site, no hand towels supplied, please bring your own. Hand gel stations in 3 locations, outside toilet, outside Secretary's caravan and at Warm Up area.

The course will consist of 8-10 fences with 1 or 2 combinations.

Riders will enter the arena when invited from Green area. They will jump round course and then halt at cone near judge. They will be asked to walk away from the judge and return at trot in as straight a line as possible past judge, then proceed to do a short show – trot in a circle, canter on both reins, a gallop or rein back are optional. Return to cone to salute judge before exiting arena.

Points will be awarded as Jumping – 60% Conformation - 20% Manners and way of going - 20%

The decision of the Judge is final and binding in all classes.

Rosettes 1-6 will be awarded and can be collected outside the arena after each class

Entries are only accepted on this understanding.
8. Unless confirmed and paid before the closing date bookings are not valid. Any withdrawals must be made by the Monday previous to show.
9. SOCIAL DISTANCING MUST BE ADHERED TO AT ALL TIMES. If anyone finds their own space is not respected please contact the organiser or secretary and they will ask person/s who are not social distancing to leave.
