

Results of Mundole Equestrian Show Jumping 04-09-22

A large entry made exciting jumping as riders had to mostly be clear to get a rosette. There were 9 clear rounds in the Cross Poles so time was the deciding factor with Vikki James, Craigellachie and Allendra Sunshine keeping a consistent pace to lead the class. Vikki was also runner up in the 0.45 just a few seconds behind Lilly Forsyth on Peppa. Lexie Innes, Buckie has taken over her mother's horse, Mylo and convincingly won both the 0.60 and 0.70, beating her mother's time on the young horse Henry by 0.9 of a second. Rachel Forbes, Nairn had a double win in the 0.80 and 0.90 with Paddy. It was the first time she had jumped the higher class but Paddy did an almost perfect round ahead of Phoebe Peppe with Alice.
